## APPLICATION FOR STUDENT GRANT

### GRANTS TO THOSE INVOLVED WITH THE BUILDING INDUSTRY

The Trust has funds available to assist those involved in the building trade.

The objectives are:

- to provide help to persons in reduced circumstances who are connected with the building trade in Edinburgh and the Lothians and also to their spouses, children and other dependent relatives
- to provide prizes and awards for university, college and further education courses involved in skills relating to the building industry
- to advance education by providing grants or other financial assistance to those involved in the building industry

In practice, the Trustees give priority to providing grants to those who are unable to work on account of sickness or injury and to their spouses, children and dependants. Applicants should be of supervisory grade (e.g. site agents) or more senior. In the first instance applicants – or those representing them – are asked to write to the Secretaries & Treasurers explaining the circumstances. The application will then be considered by the Trustees.

Prize money is given annually to each of the five local universities and colleges for presentation to an outstanding student(s) and scholarships are available – amounting to £10,000 pa for university and college students to benefit from further study, research or travel directly associated with the construction industry.

To the extent that funds are still available after paying out the above priorities, grants are awarded to individual students according to their need to assist them in the expenses relating to their courses. These grants are supplementary to other forms of finance available to students and to help with such matters as the purchase of books, travel, etc.

Applications for assistance should be sent to the Secretaries & Treasurers who will also be pleased to give any further information.
